Policy Statement

It is the policy of Claflin University to ensure the integrity of student records and to encourage communication between faculty and students.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the University's processes for changing incomplete grades.

Applicability

This policy applies to all students at Claflin University.

DEFINITION/PROCEDURES

A student is considered incomplete if they have not completed all course requirements due to circumstances beyond their control.

Incomplete grades should only be awarded under the following circumstances:

are
can reasonably make a passing grade in the course if missing assignment(s) completed);

student is unable to complete their coursework due to military, family, medical, or other circumstances (e.g., economic, child-care responsibilities, death in family, medical condition, university appointments, legal issues, government-mandated appearances (e.g., deployment, etc.);
